SETTING UP YOUR PHONE

- Remove the battery cover (apply pressure in the centre of the cover and push to slide down).
- Insert the SIM card(s) into the holder as illustrated.
- Insert your SD card (max. 2 GB) into the memory card holder with the gold contacts facing down.
- · SIM slot-1 should be chip side facing down.
- · SIM slot-2 should be chip facing upwards.
- Insert the battery, making sure that the battery contacts touch the phone's gold contacts.
- Place the battery cover so that the clips locate and slide the cover upwards to secure.
- Before you use the phone for the first time. charge the battery for at least 4 hours.

MANAGE 2 SIM CARDS AND PROFILES

You will be able to receive calls from either SIM profile.

When making a call or sending a TEXT message you will be prompted to select the SIM profile that you want to use [SIM 1 or SIM 2]. If you use different networks for each SIM card, the network name is displayed clearly below the SIM 1 or SIM 2 selection to make identification easy.
